### **Compliance Corner**

Q: What are the best storage options for the data I've collected on my IRB protocol, and how can I safely share it with my collaborators?

A: The level of data protection required will depend upon the type of information being collected and stored. Please consult <u>IRB Guidance</u>

<u>Document G-16: Guidance on Data Management Requirements for Research Data</u> for further information. Note that sensitive information and information subject to additional protections (such as HIPAA or FERPA) requires a higher level of protection, and transferring such data to 3rd party apps/software requires GVSU IT review if the items are not already on <u>IT's approved list</u>. For surveys, researchers are strongly encouraged to use the GVSU-licensed Qualtrics platform.
