The HLC QI report,	GE Director went to the AAC&U Conference and discussed assessment. It was suggested to present	
continued	results from 4-0 instead of 0-4. We will not do this since all previous graphs have been 0-4.	
	It was advised that we disaggregate the results to discuss which objectives students were proficient in. We cannot do that since a majority of instructors gave an overall score for each skill instead of for each objective.	
	We need to pare down and distribute the QI to students and faculty. Director proposed we distribute the report in mid/late fall to the campus community and then be able to discuss it with the stakeholders. This will give the GEC time to review the documents before they are distributed.	
	This current HLC report requires feedback about commitment, engagement, and support by stakeholders. The Director asked Deans, departments, and colleges for their feedback and put it verbatim in the report. Chair suggested adding Troy Farley from the Career Center as well.	
	Challenges EncounteredChair asked if we wanted to provide a percentage under the last bullet point regarding number of faculty attending FTLC training.	
	OpportunitiesMember suggested adding information about how the workshops help train faculty on assessment.
