Chair's Report – Welcome to our new member, Samantha Minnis from the Library.

Director's Report – Transfer courses are first approved by the relevant academic department and then submitted to General Education (GE) for final approval. Once approved, a course remains valid unless the corresponding course at the originating institution changes. For students studying abroad, departmental approval is required for the courses they plan to take. To streamline this process, the Padnos International Center (PIC) is developing a database of pre-approved study abroad courses with direct Grand Valley (GV) equivalencies. This will reduce the need for students to seek approval from departments each time. GE is scheduled to meet with PIC tomorrow to discuss this initiative further.

The Digital Literacy Committee wants to ensure that all students have baseline digital skills before they start at GVSU. They will be developing baseline skill expectations, including working with FTLC to break down levels of Digital Literacy. The committee would also like to know how we can incorporate Digital Literacy into GE.
