The committee would like more information about how this course fits within the Global Perspectives category. To do this, we request that you provide more specific information about how you will teach perspectives and ways of life of people in societies located primarily outside of the United States. Providing a specific content example for each knowledge learning outcome would help us understand more clearly how this course fits within the category.

We also would like more information about how you will teach the Oral Communication skills. Please explain how you will teach students each of the five objectives in the Oral Communication category before students practice the skill.

Additionally, we noticed all but one of the sample texts listed in the SOR are focused on the history of technology in the United States. As you are proposing this course for a new GE category, we suggest this could be a good opportunity to consider adding another text to the SOR that would more fully represent technology from a global perspective.
