



Honors Off-Ramp Policy for General Education Credit

If a student leaves the Honors College, the following GE credits will be awarded for HNR courses taken:

- Students who complete HNR 151 and 152 (the first semester in Honors) will receive credit for the Writing and Historical Perspectives GE categories.
- Students who complete HNR 153 and 154 (the second semester in Honors) will receive credit for the Philosophy & Literature and Global Perspectives categories, as well as one Social & Behavioral Sciences course. (They also get SWS credit.)
- Students fulfilling the HNR 200 requirement through Study Abroad will receive credit for one Issues course.
- Students who complete HNR 201 will receive credit for the Arts category.
- Students who complete HNR 250, 251, 350, and/or 351 must appeal directly to the General Education Director to make the case for appropriate GE credits.
- Students who complete HNR 401/499 will receive one Issues credit.
