



PREREQUISITE AND PERMIT POLICY

FOUNDATIONS

1. It is acceptable to have prerequisites or permits on Foundation courses but they should be very limited since Foundations are providing basic knowledge.
2. It is acceptable to have sections of Foundations courses where enrollment is limited to a certain major or because courses are linked.

CULTURES

1. It is acceptable to have prerequisites or permits on Cultures courses but they should be limited.
2. It is acceptable to have sections of Cultures courses where enrollment is limited to a certain major or because courses are linked.

ISSUES

1. It is acceptable to have prerequisites on Issues courses but they should be very limited since we want Issues courses to be open to most students.
2. It is NOT acceptable to have courses and sections for which the enrollment is limited to a certain major or because courses are linked, nor can courses or sections be permit-only.
3. Issues courses are limited to 40 students and all courses must have a Jr. Standing prerequisite.
