## **PAS Program Student Health Insurance Policy**

- 1. The PAS Program strongly encourages all learners to always have health insurance coverage in effect. Some clinical sites may require students to have health insurance to complete a rotation. Students who do not have health insurance may experience a delay in scheduling rotations which could extend the length of the program. A health insurance plan is available for PAS program students through Grand Valley State University. - 2. Medical fees incurred due to any injury or illness arising out of participation in the PAS program are the responsibility of the learner.
- 3. The student must obtain medical care from their personal health care provider or the university health center. No pro bono care should be requested from and/or provided by a clinical site preceptor or faculty member.
