

PAS Program Clinical Year Travel Policy

1. GVSU PAS students are expected to travel to assigned sites to complete clinical rotations.
2. Whenever possible, individual PAS students will be assigned to clinical rotation sites near available housing options.
3. Due to the nature of the clinical education, students may be required to travel throughout the state of Michigan to complete up to seven core rotations.
4. Students may be required to travel up to 450 miles from the primary campus location to complete assigned core clinical rotations.
5. Students are responsible for all housing, parking, and transportation costs incurred during the clinical year. Each student must secure housing at a safe and reasonable distance from assigned clinical sites to support safety and optimize learning during rotations.
6. Students will be notified of their assigned clinical sites with as much advance notice as possible to allow adequate time for travel and housing arrangements.
