PAS Program Clinical Year Travel Policy

- 1. GVSU PAS students are expected to travel to assigned sites to complete clinical rotations.
- 2. Whenever possible, individual PAS students will be assigned to clinical rotation sites near available housing options.
- 3. Due to the nature of the clinical education, students may be required to travel throughout the state of Michigan to complete up to seven core rotations.
- 4. Students may be required to travel up to 450 miles from the primary campus location to complete assigned core clinical rotations.
- 5. Students are responsible for all housing, parking, and transportation costs incurred during the clinical year. Each student must secure housing at a safe and reasonable distance from assigned clinical sites to support safety and optimize learning during rotations.
- 6. Students will be notified of their assigned clinical sites with as much advance notice as possible to allow adequate time for travel and housing arrangements.
