

PAS Program Procedure for Appeals of Action Taken Under PAS Program Academic Review Policy

1. A PAS program student may appeal an action taken under the PAS Program Academic Review Policy.
2. If a student is unsatisfied with the PAS Program decision, the student may appeal to the Dean of the College of Health Professions. Students who appeal a decision must submit a written letter of appeal to the Dean of the College of Health Professions before the first day of the start of the next semester:
3. If a student is not satisfied with the decision of the Dean of the College of Health Professions, the student may appeal to the Provost or the Provost's designee. Students who appeal a decision by the Dean of the College of Health Professions must submit a written letter of appeal to the Provost or the Provost's designee.
4. The result of each appeal shall be reported to the Associate Vice Provost for The Graduate School.
5. This appeal process complies with the process outlined in the Graduate Education Policies and Procedures Manual and the University Academic Grievance Student Procedure. Please refer to the Graduate Education Policies and Procedures Manual and the University Academic Grievance Student Procedure documents for further details of the process.
