

PAS Program Student Drug Screening Policy

1. All PAS Program Students must comply with the GVSU Senior Leadership Policy 5.1 Alcohol and Other Drugs Policy (<https://www.gvsu.edu/policies>).
2. A drug screen is required for scheduling clinical placements and by most health systems as defined in the GVSU Health Compliance Policy.
3. Students may be required to obtain repeat criminal background screening immediately before or during the clinical year.
4. Drug screening results are maintained in the student's health compliance account in Viewpoint.
5. The cost of all screenings is the responsibility of the student.
6. A non-negative drug screen may affect a student's ability to be placed at clinical sites and successfully meet program requirements. Non-negative drug screens will be handled according to the GVSU Health Compliance Policy.

The Alcohol and Other Drugs Policy Handbook (www.gvsu.edu/aces) includes information about University drug and alcohol abuse prevention programs; health risks; counseling, treatment, and rehabilitation resources; legal sanctions and summary of laws; University employee and student sanctions for violations of alcohol and other drug policies; employee notification obligations; requirements for Federal grant recipients; and links to additional University policies, procedures, and resources.
