*Begin by logging into Banner with your Banner ID and your password.

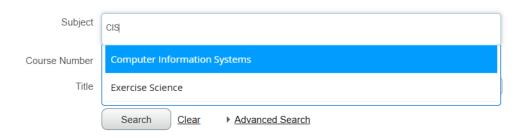
*Select a term (Fall 2025)

*'Course Number' will be the course number (such as 500, 635, etc.)

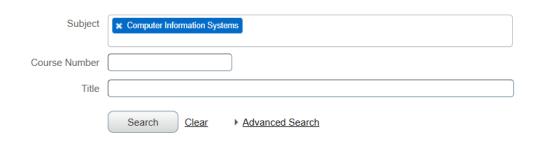

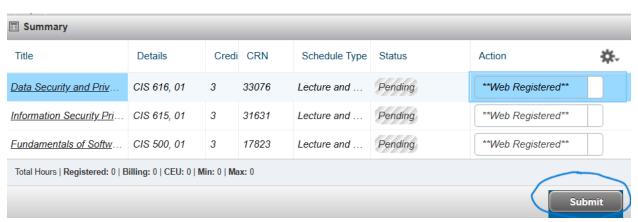


*Once you have results, click the 'Add' button on the bottom right to add that section to your schedule. Below, a student selects CIS 635-02.

*To add more classes, click 'Search Again' at the top right.

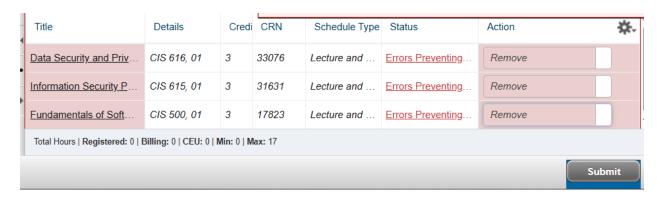


*Be sure to click 'Submit' once you've added all your classes.
