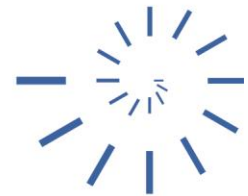

Accommodation:	Organized for the students, who pay themselves. Price € 232 / month.
Cost of living:	€ 600 – 700 / month (including accommodation, subsistence, health insurance, etc.)
German language courses:	on-going courses during term: beginners level A1 (only summer semester) and advanced level B1, B2, C1. Students with German knowledge are welcomed to attend our regular courses.
Modules in English:	<i>Winter semester:</i> English Department (Literature, Linguistics, Area Studies, TESL) <i>Summer semester:</i> English Department (Literature, Linguistics, Areas Studies, TESL), Intercultural Studies, Education, Teaching Methodologies. 	Teacher Training students with no or little knowledge of the German language are welcome in the summer semester.
Practice teaching:	Observation in school classes of all age groups; opportunities to teach English actively in grades 1 – 4 or 5 – 9/10.
Study fees:	No tuition fee. Administration fee (including bus ticket): € 100.
International students:	Each semester we welcome about 20 international exchange students from Europe, the US and Asia. This number enables us to meet the individual needs for our students.
International activities:	International short course week in April (in English); Organized, subsidized social and cultural activities with German and international students.
About Schwäbisch Gmünd:	The largely preserved medieval town has about 60.000 inhabitants. Stuttgart, the capital of South-West Germany, is only 40 minutes away by train (50 km away). Other cities nearby and places of interest for a day-trip are: Ulm, Heidelberg, Nuremberg, Munich, Lake Constance etc.
Location:	Closest international airport: Stuttgart (approx. 1 hour by train)
