#### Why study abroad in Honors?

"Live, Learn, Lead" is the philosophy that shapes the Honors College curriculum at GVSU. Study abroad allows students to experience this first hand almost anywhere in the world. Imagine walking through a crowded street filled with the aromas of the food vendors and fish dealers in Costa Rica, or studying development and social change in Nepal. Honors students who choose to study abroad will live in a foreign country, immersed in a culture different from their own. Students will learn from a unique perspective and through self-discovery. ### Where can an Honors student go?



Anywhere! Honors students have a wide variety of Study Abroad programs and locations to choose from. Programs range from two weeks to a full year abroad and a student can study abroad as early as the summer after their freshman year. The Honors College facilitates Faculty-Led programs to Haiti and Israel, but an Honors student can participate in any available program. ## HNR 300 Campus/Community Engagement Abroad

Students may substitute any course they take abroad for HNR 401/499. Substitutions must be approved by an Honors advisor and a reflection paper will be required to fulfill this requirement.
