Visa Guidelines – JAPAN

Students who plan to study in Japan for more than 90 days must apply for a visa. The information below provides general guidelines regarding the visa application process and required documents. This information can change and students should always refer to the Japanese consulate's website for the most up to date application procedures.

Students who are residents of Michigan will apply for their visa at the Japanese Consulate in Detroit. If you are a resident of another state, check the Japanese Consulate website for information on which office has jurisdiction over your state of residence.

Residents of Michigan's Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties must submit visa applications in person at the consulate office and are required to pick up the visa in person.

Residents outside this tri-county area may submit applications by mail, if necessary.
