

Visa Guidelines - MEXICO

The information below provides general guidelines regarding the visa application process and required documents. This information can change frequently and students should always refer to the Mexican consulate's website for the most up to date application procedures, required documents, and visa fees.

Permanent residents of Michigan will be required to work through the Mexican Consulate in Detroit. If you are a permanent resident of another state, you must research which Consulate has jurisdiction over your home state.

Please look over the visa information carefully and do not delay, as visa procedures can be complicated and subject to change.
