**Eligibility Criteria**

- 1) Applicants must meet the minimum eligibility criteria for participation in the program for which they are applying.
- 2) Applicants must be accepted by PIC for study abroad.
- 3) Students must file a FAFSA.
- 4) Applicants with an Expected Family Contribution (EFC) of more than \$30,000 will not be eligible for a partnership grant.
- 5) There are a designated number of grants for each program. If there are more applicants than grants available, decisions on awards will be made by the PIC Grant Review Committee. This committee will consider the strength of a student's study abroad application, and the student's financial need when making determinations on which students will receive the award.
- 6) Students who apply by the priority deadline will automatically be considered for the Partnership Grant. Any student who completes an application for study abroad after the priority deadline may not receive the Partnership Grant. After the priority deadline, awards will be subject to available funding.
- 7) Students who are awarded other PIC funding (i.e. Murray Scholarship, Padnos Scholarship) may not be awarded a Partnership Grant.
- 8) Students are not eligible for both the Study Abroad Grant and the Partnership Grant. Partnership Grants may be awarded at a level higher than what is listed above based on a student's financial need.

\* Students who receive the generous JASSO Scholarship will not be eligible for the partnership grant.
