Residents of Michigan will consult the Swiss Consulate in New York for application instructions. Non-MI residents must apply for their student visa under the consulate that has jurisdiction over your place of permanent residence.

Please look over the visa information carefully and do not delay, as visa procedures can be complicated and subject to change.
