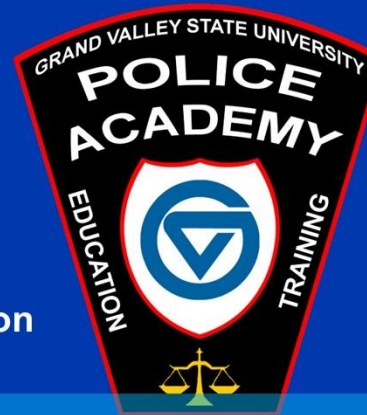

Pay

Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Possess good moral character
- Possess good reading and writing skills
- Possess a valid drivers license
- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Have a record clear of any felonies and certain misdemeanors

- Civil Service Exam
- Submit background questionnaire
- Complete MCOLES reading/writing and physical fitness (sponsorship only)
- Oral Board Interview
- Full background investigation
- Chief's Interview
- Conditional offer of employment - psych and physical
- Attend GVSU Police Academy (sponsorship only)

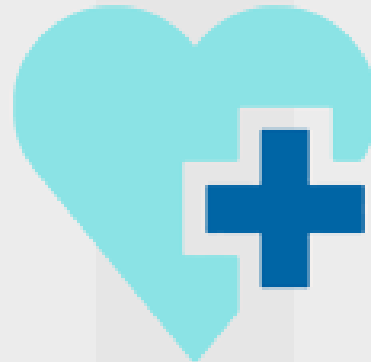

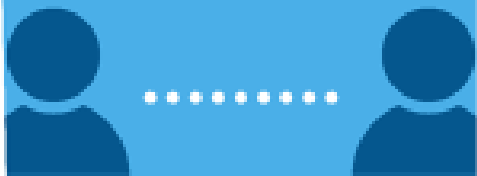
