



- As part of our ongoing commitment to promote diversity within the legal profession, the law firm of Warner Norcross + Judd announces the fifteenth year of our LSAT Preparation Course Scholarship program. The program provides scholarships, up to \$1,500 each, to enable racially and/or ethnically diverse college students to participate in a study course to prepare them to take the Law School Admissions Test (LSAT).
- Scholarships will cover the cost of tuition for an LSAT Preparation Course offered by Kaplan Test Prep and Admissions. Students generally take the LSAT exam in June before beginning their senior year or in September of their senior year.   - Take the LSAT prep course by December 31, 2021

## Description

- Answer emergency and non-emergency calls for service from citizens
- Handle criminal and non-criminal reports and complaints
- Assist with various administrative functions such as testifying in court
- Work 12 hour shifts while on patrol
- Availability to work; days, nights, weekends, and holidays

## Additional Opportunities

- Specialty units such as Training, Community Engagement, Traffic, Detective, K9, and V.I.C.E.
- Secondary assignments such as recruiter, bomb tech, mounted unit, training officer, and bike patrol
- Lateral officers with 3+ years experience receive a higher pay rate
- Out of state officers can be reimbursed for the Recognition of Prior Training (MCOLES RPTE) course
- Offer a sponsorship once a year for those who have not attended a police academy

## Pay

- Starting pay through June 2021 is set at \$23.11 per hour
- Top pay through June 2021 is set at \$37.84 per hour

## Requirements

- Must be at least 18 years old
- Must have a high school diploma or GED
- Possess good moral character
- Possess good reading and writing skills
- Possess a valid drivers license
- Be a U.S. Citizen
- Have a record clear of any felonies and certain misdemeanors

- Civil Service Exam
- Submit background questionnaire
- Complete MCOLES reading/writing and physical fitness (sponsorship only)
- Oral Board Interview
- Full background investigation
- Chief's Interview
- Conditional offer of employment - psych and physical
- Attend GVSU Police Academy (sponsorship only)


