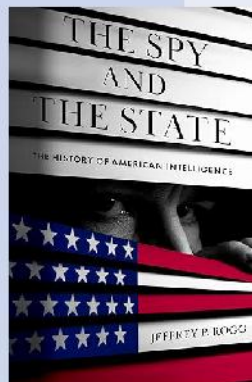

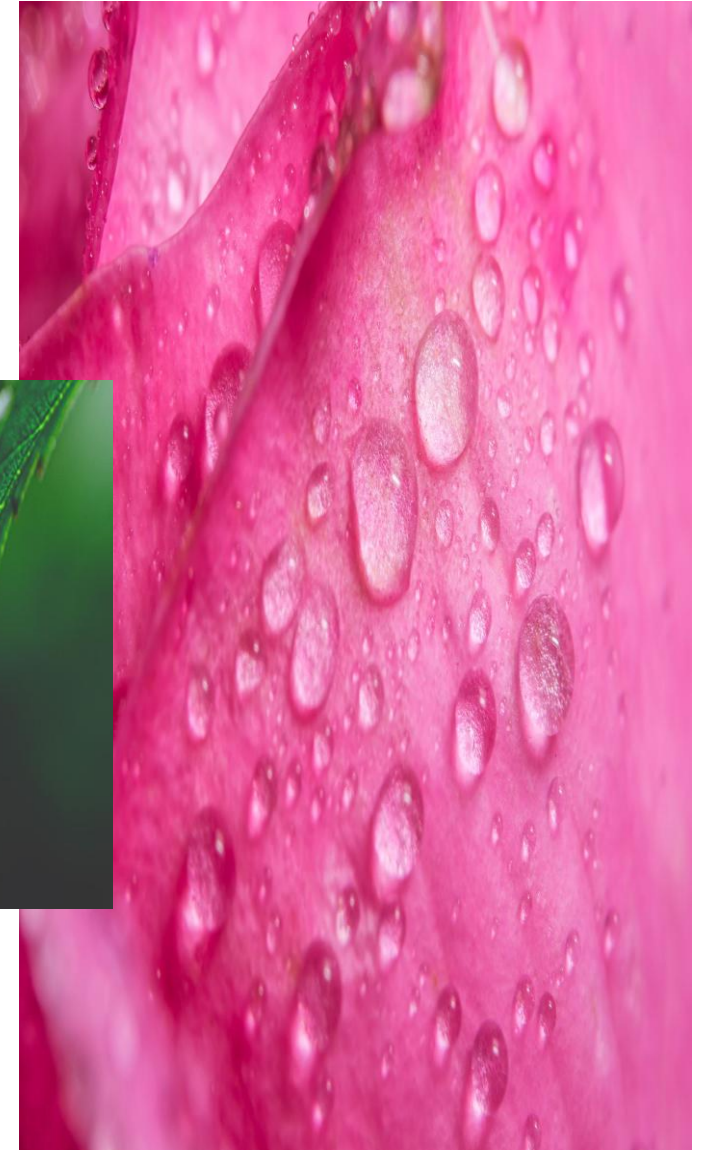
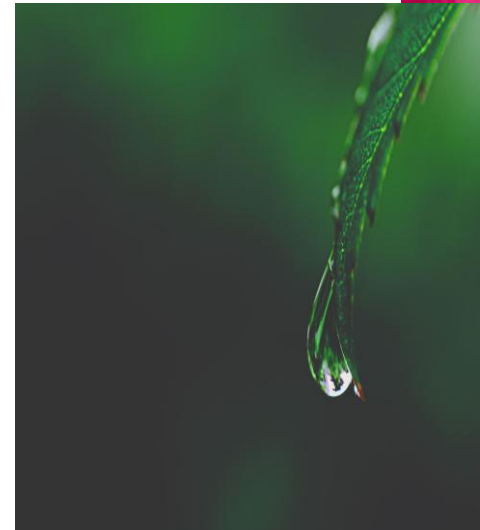

Holland Police Department Cadet

Criminal Justice or Related Field Students

Students who are enrolled or soon to be enrolled in a Criminal Justice or related field are eligible to apply for this part-time position that is designed to give college students an opportunity to see what it is like to work for our department. We currently have open positions at the police department that are part-time hours during the school year and full-time hours for 10 weeks during the summer. The pay is \$16.14-\$18.60, hourly.

Customer Service Role

Cadets are given the opportunity to serve in a customer service role at the front desk of the police lobby. This includes answering phones and assisting the public with obtaining information. Cadets assist with booking duties in the jail as well as enforcing certain parking violations. Police cadets are given the opportunity to interact with the public through programs like the Junior Police Academy as well as other public events hosted by the city.

Duties

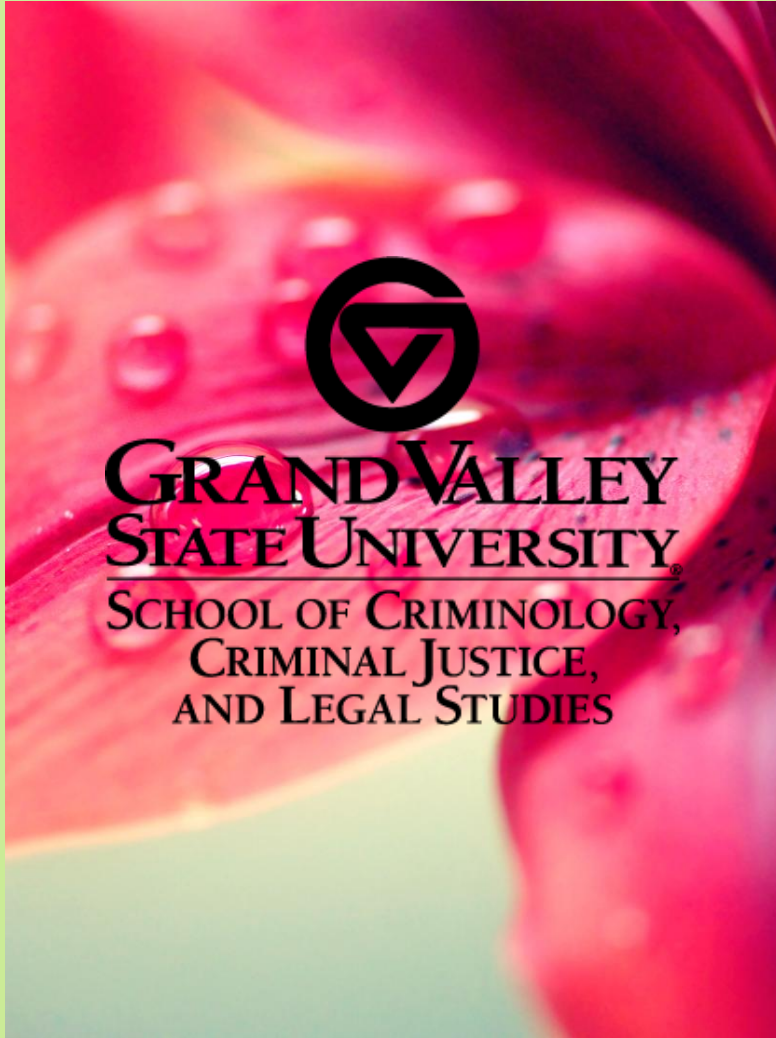
- Jail and booking operations assistance
- Customer service at the police lobby
- Maintain law enforcement records
- Work an average of 20 hours per week during the school year
- Work approximately 40 hours per week during summer and/or school breaks
- Provide internal and external customer service.
- Assist customers with fingerprinting, gun permits/registration, sex offender registration, report requests, traffic citations, customer service, and many other functions.
- Code Enforcement activities, including ticketing and animal complaints.
