Holland Police Department Cadet

Criminal Justice or Related Field Students

Students who are enrolled or soon to be enrolled in a Criminal Justice or related field are eligible to apply for this part-time position that is designed to give college students an opportunity to see what it is like to work for our department. We currently have open positions at the police department that are part-time hours during the school year and full-time hours for 10 weeks during the summer. The pay is \$16.14-\$18.60, hourly.

Customer Service Role

Cadets are given the opportunity to serve in a customer service role at the front desk of the police lobby. This includes answering phones and assisting the public with obtaining information. Cadets assist with booking duties in the jail as well as enforcing certain parking violations. Police cadets are given the opportunity to interact with the public through programs like the Junior Police Academy as well as other public events hosted by the city.

Duties

- Jail and booking operations assistance
- Customer service at the police lobby
- Maintain law enforcement records
- Work an average of 20 hours per week during the school year
- Work approximately 40 hours per week during summer and/or school breaks
- Provide internal and external customer service.
- Assist customers with fingerprinting, gun permits/registration, sex offender registration, report requests, traffic citations, customer service, and many other functions.
- Code Enforcement activities, including ticketing and animal complaints.

CONSERVATION OFFICER CADET ACADEMY

The Michigan DNR Conservation Officer Cadet Academy, July 19-24, 2026 is a free career exploration opportunity for individuals interested in a career as a CO.

Cadets will receive training and real-life experience while lodging for five nights at the DNR's Ralph A. MacMullan Conference Center, located on Higgins Lake in Roscommon. COs will lead cadets through morning physical training, then follow a daily agenda similar to the CO Training Academy, covering a number of subjects, including:

- Conservation law
- Hunting regulations and enforcement
- Marine safety
- Water safety
- Off-road vehicle operation
- Search and rescue
- Survival tactics
- First aid



Eligibility

All applicants must meet the following criteria to be considered:

- 18-21 years of age.
- Must be a senior in high school, a high school graduate or enrolled in college, trade school, or military with a GPA of 2.5 or higher (most recent transcript and proof of current enrollment are required), and/or provide proof of employment.
- Interested in pursuing a career in law enforcement or natural resources.
- Have no felony or misdemeanor convictions within the past three years.
- Must be willing to lodge overnight at the RAM Center and participate in all activities, which will be directly supervised by conservation officers.
- Successfully complete and submit all of the required documents and forms.
