STUDY ABROAD

Japan: Criminal Justice (Japan Center for Michigan Universities)

Hikone, Japan - We will explore the criminal justice system and Japanese culture that keeps Japan one of the safest countries in the world. We will learn Japanese culture and history in the classroom, and through cultural events and field trips to Tokyo, Kyoto, Nara and Hiroshima. We will visit various criminal justice entities, including policing organizations, courts, a prison, and a juvenile detention center (subject to availability).

No Japanese language skills required. Open to all both undergraduate and graduate students.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED

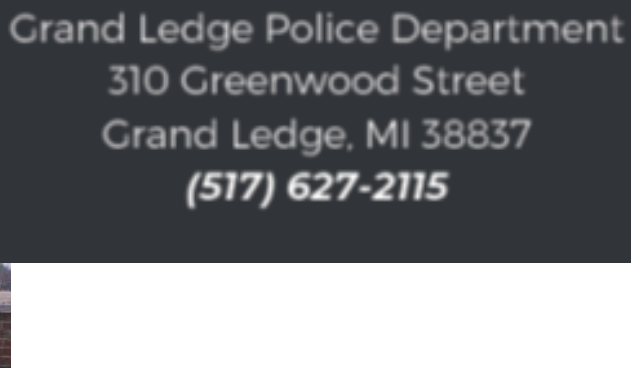
- When: 8:00-2:30 Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday
