



Warner Norcross + Judd 2018 LSAT Scholarship Program – Applications Due 4/30/18

As part of our ongoing commitment to promote diversity within the legal profession, the law firm of Warner Norcross + Judd announces the 11th annual LSAT Preparation Course Scholarship program. The program provides scholarships, up to \$1,500 each, to enable minority college students to participate in a study course to prepare them to take the Law School Admissions Test (LSAT).

Scholarships will cover the cost of tuition for an LSAT Preparation Course offered by Kaplan Test Prep and Admissions. Students generally take the LSAT exam in June before beginning their senior year or in September of their senior year. The LSAT classroom preparation course consists of 10 sessions (7 teaching sessions and 3 exam sessions). Online courses are also available. More information can be found on the Kaplan web site at www.kaptest.com.

To be eligible for a scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a Michigan resident or currently attending a Michigan college or university
- Be a junior or a senior during the 2017-2018 academic year
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher
- Have a demonstrated financial need
- Take the LSAT prep course by December 31, 2018

- Please submit your [graduation application](#) to the Registrar's Office via myBanner. Select Student, Student Records, and Apply to Graduate. When selecting the term of graduation, students should select the semester in which their degree requirements will be **complete**.
- Students must apply for graduation to be invited to the commencement ceremony. If you intend to **have your name printed in the commencement program**, students should submit their applications prior to March 9, 2018 for the April 2018 ceremony.
- Students completing their degree requirements in the Spring/Summer 2018 semester and who apply for graduation prior to the last week of the Winter 2018 semester are automatically invited to April's ceremony. Those Spring/Summer 2018 graduates who apply after this point will be invited to December's ceremony.
