Please remember, registration dates are typically assigned the week before registration begins.

- >Login to myBanner
- >Select "Student"
- >Select "Registration"
- >Select "Prepare for Registration"
- >Click on "View Registration Status"
- >Select Term
- >Show Time Ticket and holds info

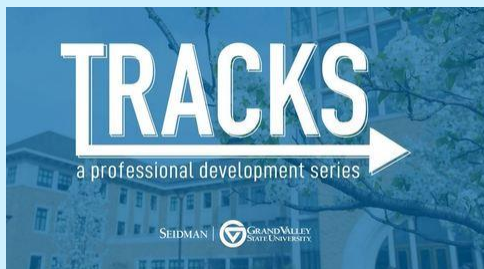
