Meaningful, Timely On-line Discussion Courses BUS 280/380 1-Credit Courses

Looking for something to address the impact COVID-19 is having on the business community over the spring & summer? We are offering several 1 credit BUS 280/380 online discussion courses to help process the current situation.

- Utilize these 1 cr. Courses to earn credits toward 120.
- Combine 3 -1 cr. 280/380 (any combination, including 3 280 sections) to satisfy
 1 Seidman Upper Division Elective.
- These courses are graded as C/NC.
- Leverage these course options to receive TRACKS* credit here is how...
- TRACKS Completion requires that students attend 8 professional development events. 3 of which are specifically required events and 5 are optional.
- By enrolling in one of the BUS 280 or 380 courses (COVID related or otherwise), students can fulfill 2 optional events of the TRACKS Program. Since the courses are interdisciplinary in nature they will cover multiple tracks within the one course, and provide immediate relevance as students enter a changed workforce.

EXAMPLE:

Enroll in ONE section of BUS 280/BUS 380 = 2 optional events fulfilled.

Enroll in TWO sections of BUS 280/380 = 4 optional events fulfilled.

*Students will still be required to submit a reflection essay to earn TRACKS credit. However, if the course requires a culminating essay or project/proposal, that will also be accepted as a reflection essay.
