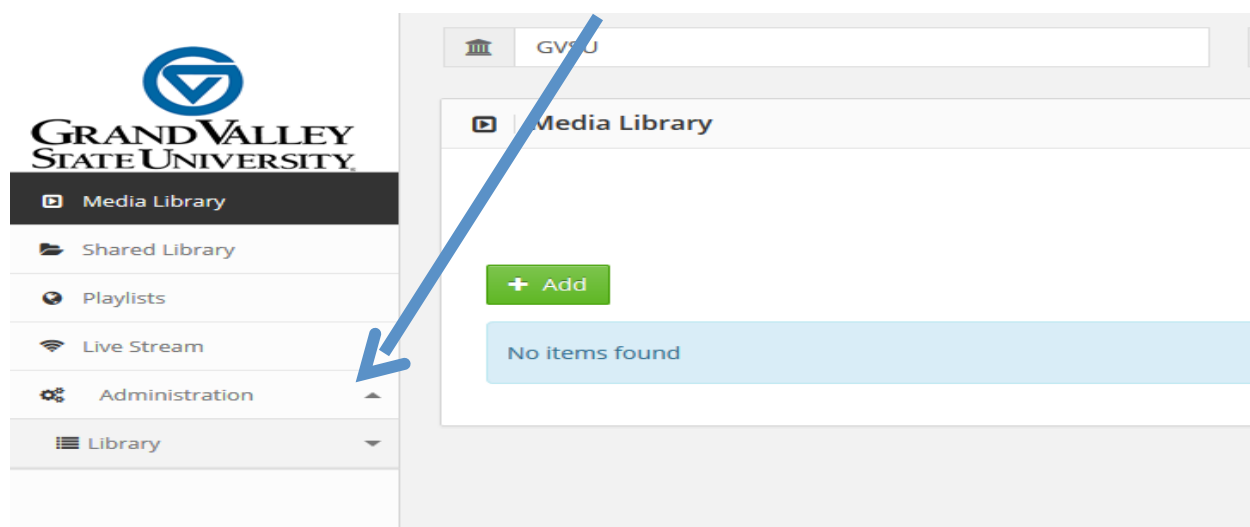

Once logged into Ensemble, click on the “Administration” Tab.

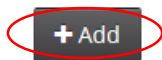
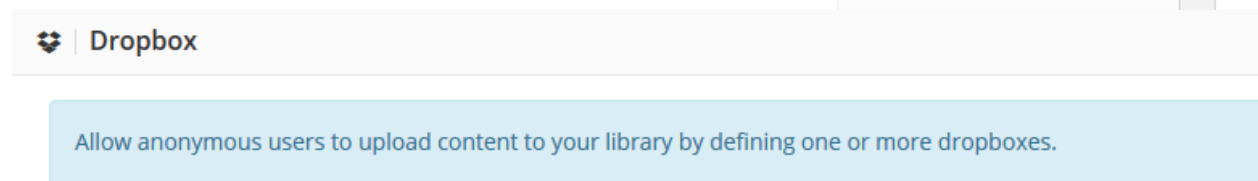
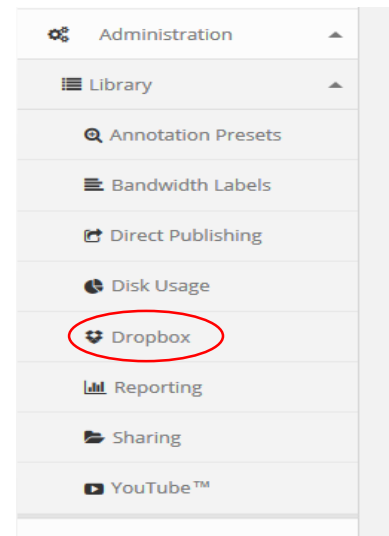
