- 3) Report from the Chair
 - a) Programs may use grades from individual assignments/projects/activities as assessment measures, but course grades are discouraged. Course grades are composites of many assignments and not reflective of SLOs/SCOs; grades on individual assignments are more focused. - 4) Report from the Provost’s Office
 - a) ABET is visiting campus to review the Occupational Safety and Health Program
 - b) Lancaster reached out to HLC for clarification about assessing minors that are not connected to majors. HLC confirmed that these minors need to be assessed like programs for majors.
 - c) Lancaster mentioned the need for a data sharing policy to facilitate requests for student data while maintaining privacy and adhering to FERPA. Some programs rely heavily on courses taught outside their department or college for majors and minors, data sharing becomes important to support these programs.
- 5) New Business

- a) To facilitate restarting the assessment plan review process, we will use breakout rooms for small group review and training of current assessment plan assignments.
 - i) Schymik noted that some programs have submitted assessment plans that drew from their past plans. This is appropriate if programs choose to do this.
 - ii) Hasenbank asked about curriculum maps, should they focus on the SLOs/SCOs in the current assessment plan or on all the SLOs/SCOs a program might have. Either option is fine. The intent of the curriculum maps is to help UAC have some context into the structure of programs.
