VP Hall-Jones

Signed the Okanagan Charter that we will be a well-being campus. AVP Harmon has created a well-being master plan. Reorganized a new health and well-being center and expanded staffing. Student health facility moving to self-pay and eliminating contract with Trinity Health, will be hired & staffed through GVSU. Peer-to-peer mental health support does trainings for peer groups as well.

Discussion around expanding laptop loaner programs, desktops in computer labs are underutilized. Replenish has been the focus of day of giving, and the division continues to look for grants to support this work. Emergency housing opportunities are available for students.
