LS 101 Law in our Lives LS 224 Legal Research (*Prerequisites: LS 101 with C grade or better*) LS 324 Legal Writing (SWS) (Prerequisites: LS 224 & WRT 150 – both with C grade or better) LS 226 Civil Litigation I (Prerequisite: LS 101; may be taken concurrently\*) LS 320 Property & Probate Law (Prerequisite: LS 101; may be taken concurrently\*) LS 322 Commercial Law (Prerequisite: LS 101; may be taken concurrently\*) LS 428 Civil Litigation II (Prerequisite: LS 101; may be taken concurrently\*) LS 490 Legal Studies Internship (Prerequisites: Senior Standing, LS 101, LS 324, LS 226, and Permission of Internship Coordinator) OR LS 495 Legal Thought (Prerequisites: LS 101, LS 324, and Senior Standing)

\*Although LS 101 can be taken concurrently with LS 226, LS 320, and LS 322, you should meet with an advisor to determine if it is appropriate for your academic plan and timeline. You will be better prepared by taking the courses in the recommended order.
