- **Don't forget to register!** Summer and fall/winter registration is open — log into Banner and lock in your schedule before sections fill up. Not sure what to take? Schedule an advising appointment and we'll help you plan ahead. Connect with your advisor if you need support!

 - **Incomplete Grade Request**
 - **Need more time to finish a course? You may qualify for an Incomplete (I) grade.** An incomplete is an option if you're passing the course but can't finish due to circumstances outside your control. It's typically only granted during the last 20% of the semester, and the remaining work must be a small portion of the course.
 - Talk to your instructor first, then reach out to your advisor if you have questions.
 - **Repeat a Course Process**
 - You can repeat any course **one time** without special permission. When you do, the most recent grade replaces the original in your GPA and credit hours — even if the new grade is lower. Both grades will still show on your transcript. Grades of I, W, AU, CR, or NC don't count as a repeat and won't replace a previous grade.
 - **Financial aid may also be affected** by repeating courses. [Check the Financial Aid website for details.](#)

 - **Academic Grievance**
 - An academic grievance lets you formally challenge things like a course grade, a program requirement decision, or a graduation requirement ruling. If something doesn't seem right, don't wait — you must file a grievance **by the end of the next regular semester** after you receive the grade or decision. If you need to appeal after that, you have **15 business days** from when you're notified of the outcome.
