



EDUCATIONAL REQUIREMENTS FOR PROFESSIONAL LICENSURE AND CERTIFICATION

Federal [Department of Education](#) Regulations. Federal regulations require all colleges and universities to publicly disclose whether their programs (traditional, online, or hybrid – regardless of modality) that lead or may lead to professional licensure or certification meet educational requirements. State professional licensure/certification laws, regulations, and policies are subject to change at any time, and many boards/agencies require more than successful degree completion to obtain a license/certification. Unless otherwise indicated below, a degree program alone may not be sufficient to provide the content required to pass certification or professional designation exams in a particular discipline for professional certification or designation in a professional organization, association, society, and the like. Thus, the information below should not be viewed as a guarantee that any professional licensure/certification authority will approve a student's application.

All current and prospective students are encouraged to contact the applicable licensure/certification boards in their state of residence or the state in which they intend to obtain a license/certificate for additional and the most up-to-date information regarding professional licensure and certification requirements, including, but not limited to, information regarding prerequisites, examinations, or any non-educational requirements, such as work experience, background clearance, examination by outside entities, finger printing requirements, etc.

5. Column 5 – All U.S. jurisdictions for which “NO DETERMINATION” has been made for the program/course regarding the state educational requirements
 - a. Teaching Certification Reciprocity allows teaching candidates who hold an out-of-state license to earn a license in a receiving state, subject to meeting state-specific requirements; thus, interstate reciprocity is not automatic. Most states have policies in place to improve reciprocity for certain teachers, but few states provide full reciprocity for all fully licensed teachers, and the state teacher licensing agency reviews teaching certificate reciprocity on a case-by-case basis. Teachers must apply for a new license if they are looking to teach in a state where they are not currently licensed. Reciprocity agreements allow states to work through variations in licensing systems to coordinate license transfers and fill vacant teaching positions with qualified candidates. States that participate in teaching certification reciprocity agreements usually allow educators who move from one state to another additional time to fulfill the new state’s requirements while teaching on a temporary or provisional license basis. Students are encouraged to visit the [Educational Commission of the States](#) website to obtain state-specific reciprocity information.

Social Work Interstate Licensure Compact (*not yet enacted*). The National Association of Social Workers (NASW) released the Social Work Interstate Model Bill on February 23, 2027, which will expand opportunities for social workers to provide services in multiple states. Seven states must enact the Model Social Work Compact Bill before the Compact Commission is established. Missouri, South Dakota, Utah, and Washington have passed the bill, and the legislation has been introduced in two dozen other states. Alabama - State authorization to provide a program related to the preparation of teachers or other P-12 school/system personnel does not indicate eligibility for an Alabama certificate. Applicants for an [Alabama certificate based on reciprocity](#) must meet Alabama’s test requirements and submit a valid, renewable professional educator certificate/license issued by another state at the degree level, grade level, and in the teaching field or area of instructional support for which an Alabama certificate is sought and for which Alabama issues a certificate. Applicants for [Alabama certification in an area of administration](#) must also document at least three years of full-time employment as an administrator in a P-12 school system(s). Alabama State Department of Education website www.alsde.edu.

Alaska – The Alaska Department of Education and Early Development has [state history course requirements](#) that can be completed after initial licensure. A one-year, nonrenewable, provisional license is given to those who have met the degree/internship requirement but have not completed a history course/workshop. For additional information regarding certification requirements and regulations, visit the [Alaska Department of Education and Early Development](#) website.

Arkansas – The Arkansas Division of Elementary and Secondary Education has state history course requirements that consist of at least three (3) college credit hours in Arkansas history at an accredited institution of higher education. A one-year, nonrenewable, provisional license is given to those who have met the degree/internship requirement but have not completed a history course/workshop. For additional information regarding licensure requirements and regulations, visit the Arkansas Division of Elementary and Secondary Education website.

California – The California Commission on Teacher Credentialing regulations require a comparable teaching credential earned in a state or U.S. Territory other than California based upon completion of a professional preparation program (or alternative program) in secondary education, including student teaching, taken at a regionally- accredited institution. The credential does not have to be valid at the time of application.

Massachusetts – The Massachusetts Department of Elementary and Secondary Education requires endorsements in Sheltered English Immersion, Transition Specialist, Bilingual Education, and a voluntary endorsement in Autism. For additional information regarding other education licensure requirements and licensure regulations, visit the Massachusetts Office of Educator Licensure website.

Nebraska – The Nebraska Department of Education requires Human Relations Training and Special Education Training for anyone who holds an educator certificate or permit in Nebraska. For additional information regarding other certification requirements and licensure regulations, visit the Nebraska Board of Education website.

South Dakota – South Dakota (Codified Law 13-1-48) requires any teacher new to the profession, from out-of-state, or certified after 1993 shall complete a three (3) credit hour course in South Dakota Indian Studies. For additional information regarding certification requirements and licensure regulations, visit the South Dakota Department of Education website.

Texas - Without a standard teaching certificate, applicants are not eligible for a review of credentials and the Texas Education Agency does not review transcripts, degree level or completion of program coursework, even if the applicant has already sat for exams. Individuals without a standard teaching certificate must either complete the process in their state or would be required to go through a Texas Educator Preparation Program.

Virginia – The Virginia Board of Education requires those seeking initial licensure to complete the following: Training in cultural competency; completion of certification or training in emergency first aid; cardiopulmonary resuscitation; and use of automated external defibrillators. Study in attention deficit disorder, gifted education, methods of improving communication between schools and families, study in child abuse recognition and intervention. Any teacher responsible for teaching the state-developed African American History elective course must have either a history (2300) or history and social (2700) endorsement. Persons with an endorsement as a school counselor shall complete mandatory Dyslexia Training awareness training on indicators of dyslexia and recognition of mental health disorder and behavioral distress. Nursing License Compact (NLC). The NLC is an agreement between states that allows nurses to have one compact state nursing license that gives them the ability to practice in other states that are part of the agreement. Nurses who live in a compact state can apply for a multistate license if they meet the licensure requirements. Alabama – State approval of a program to offer Alabama licensed nurses’ opportunities for advanced degrees does not indicate eligibility for approval to practice as an advanced practice nurse in Alabama. Applicants for approval in Alabama are required to meet the Alabama requirements for national certification, graduation from a specific-type program for the advanced practice approval, and completion of the appropriate application. Any program offering a pre-licensure track to Alabama students shall meet the requirements of the Alabama regulations for

pre-licensure programs or the graduates may not be eligible to take the national licensure examination required by the Alabama Board of Nursing to enter the practice. www.abn.alabama.gov.
