

Complex Numbers

TI-82

- The **TI-82** cannot do operations with complex numbers.

TI-83 and TI-84

- On the **TI-83** and **84**, there is a little script i above the decimal point.
- You may need to change MODE from Real to a+bi.

TI-85 and TI-86

- The **TI-85** and **TI-86** use a different notation.
- Rather than a+bi, they use (a,b).
- For example, to enter $(4+i)+(5+i)$, type (4,1)+(5,1).
- The calculator will give (9,2), i.e. 9+2i, as the answer.
