Now Available in Workday: Academic Participation & Tuition Reduction

Employees can now submit Academic Participation and Tuition Reduction requests directly in Workday. Simply enter your course information, complete the request, and submit it for manager approval, all within Workday.

The same process can also be used to request Tuition Reduction benefits for an eligible dependent.

Moving this process to Workday eliminates paper forms and provides a more convenient way to submit and track requests.

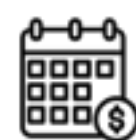
Workday Student Unit Readiness Teams

Speak Workday: Program of Study

In Workday, a **Program of Study** refers to a student's educational objective (major, minor, certificate, badge) and is used to display degree requirements on the Academic Progress Report. Students may have multiple programs of study, but one must be designated as their primary program.
