## Workday Student Enters Final Design Stage

The design phase for Workday Student will conclude in March. During this phase, GVSU teams worked closely with our implementation partner, Alchemy, to define how student processes (like registration, advising, curriculum, and records) will function in the new system.

After the design work is complete, the [Workday Student Project Team](#) will begin extensive testing throughout the spring and summer. GVSU will start its first activities in Workday Student in late 2026, with larger transitions and activities taking place throughout 2027.
