Workday Feature Updates Scheduled for March 15

Workday regularly releases new features and enhancements to improve functionality. The first major release of 2026 will take place on March 15. You may notice small system updates and minor visual changes.

One change you'll see is a slight adjustment to the location of the search bar. On the homepage, the search bar will appear slightly lower on the screen. When you navigate to another page within Workday, it will return to the top of the page.



Workday Student End-to-End Testing

The Workday Student Project team will start the End-to-End (E2E) testing on March 16. During this intensive 12-week period, project teams will comprehensively test from start to finish. This phase is critical to ensuring the system works as intended at go-live. Additional testing events with expanded campus participation, including students, will take place August -September.

Many staff in certain areas are highly involved in testing. Some departments may experience slightly longer response times during this period. We appreciate your patience and understanding as teams dedicate time to this important milestone.



Speak Workday: Program of Study

In Workday, a **Program of Study** refers to a major, minor, certificate, or badge. Each student must have one primary program of study, typically the first major they declare. Students may have multiple programs of study (for example, two majors and a badge), but only one can be designated as primary. Workday uses the primary program of study to organize a student's degree requirements and track academic progress.
