It focuses on small group and project based learning in order to deliver an authentic and interdisciplinary curricular experience for students. Additionally, it utilizes its campus to deliver an educational experience that is environmentally focused and place based with students spending a significant amount of time out of doors. 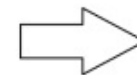
The Greenspire School is an established charter school serving middle school students in the Traverse City area that uses project-based and outdoor learning to support students and families needs.

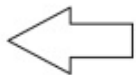

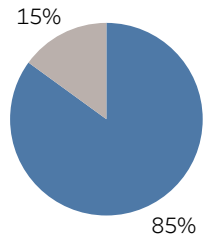
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2019-20 Student Resident Districts
