Summary

Westfield Charter Academy is a K-6 charter public school in Redford that strives to provide students a strong moral focus program and a rigorous college-prep education. The academy's goal is for students to develop the moral strength, knowledge, and skills they need to succeed in college, work, and life.

Highlights

Four staff members were nominated for an NHA Educator of Excellence award.

The academy increased overall M-STEP scores from the previous year and increased in ELA in all grades.

Daily attendance at the academy increased from 85% to 89%.

CSO Capacity Analysis

Westfield Charter Academy has achieved consistency in operations and is financially stable. The CSO notes that the other school in the academy's district (Westfield Preparatory High School) was identified as a Partnership District by the Michigan Department of Education. While this identification does not stem from specific activities at Westfield Charter Academy, the CSO has observed that the academy is proactively working to further amplify instructional outcomes and school culture. The CSO has observed that students and parents are engaged in the community, resulting in a school culture that students and families find welcoming. The CSO has also observed that the board of directors is supportive and engaged in the academy's mission. The CSO has confidence in the academy's capacity to continue to improve its academic program quality during the remaining term of its charter contract.


