## CSO Capacity Analysis

University Preparatory Art & Design has demonstrated organizational and fiscal stability; however, its academic performance has historically lagged that of statistically similar schools. Its academic performance has also required the school to enter into a “Partnership Agreement” with the Michigan Department of Education, which has prompted more focused support from the CSO and a change in school management. The CSO has observed that the academy has implemented a strong Multi-Tiered Support System and culturally responsive practices to promote restorative justice and equity. The CSO also observed a strong focus on the arts, which is a core component of the academy’s mission. This evidence provides the CSO with confidence that the academy is continuing to refine its internal capacity to rapidly accelerate student achievement while maintaining fidelity with its mission.

## Summary

University Preparatory Art & Design Elementary (K-5) opened in 2012. Located in Detroit, over 400 students are enrolled in kindergarten through fifth grade.

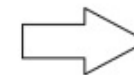
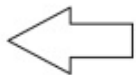

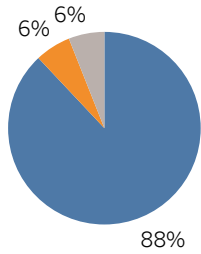
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## 2019-20 Student Resident Districts
