## CSO Capacity Analysis

Grand River Academy's ("GRA's") charter contract expires on June 30, 2021. To inform the renewal process, the CSO has conducted a comprehensive review of evidence of the school's capacity relative to expectations established in GVSU's charter renewal guidelines, a virtual site renewal visit, and stakeholder focus groups to assess GRA's academic, organizational, and fiscal performance. During this process the CSO observed a strong leadership team, consistent implementation of key design elements of the school, and generally strong organizational and fiscal capabilities. Consistent high-quality instruction was not evident. Also, the CSO observed that additional progress is needed toward building a strong culture of diversity, equity, and inclusion. In total, this evidence provides the CSO with confidence that the school has the internal capacity to strengthen its educational program and deliver strong academic results during the subsequent term of its charter contract.

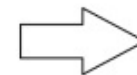
## Summary

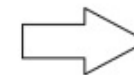
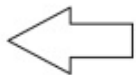

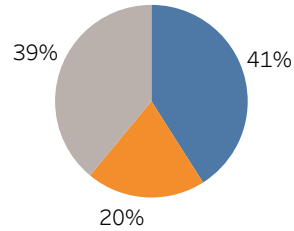
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## 2019-20 Student Resident Districts
