## CSO Capacity Analysis

Consistent with other campuses under the University Preparatory Science and Math (“UPSM”) charter, UPSM High School demonstrated both educational and organizational strength. During the 2018 renewal process, the CSO noted a low matriculation rate of middle school students to UPSM high school, and the CSO has since observed an intentional focus to address this and a year-over-year increase in enrollment. The CSO also saw evidence that the UPSM system is focusing on retaining students through high school. The CSO anticipates that this will result in increased academic outcomes. The CSO is confident in the school’s internal capacity to deliver positive academic results for students and continuously improve.

## Summary

Founded in 2010, UPSM High School educates approximately 500 students, the overwhelming majority of whom are from Detroit. Its educational program is based on a rigorous curriculum and real-world problem solving.

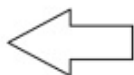

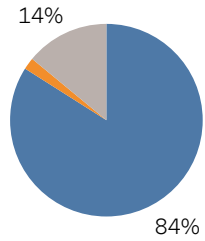
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## 2019-20 Student Resident Districts
