CSO Capacity Analysis


The Charter Schools Office (CSO) has observed that Warrendale Charter Academy continues to consistently meet annual enrollment targets and demonstrates fiscal stability. Organizational concerns previously observed by the CSO have been addressed by school leadership. However, the CSO observed there continues to be a higher teacher turnover rate and teacher shortage in core subjects, resulting in low educational outcomes for certain courses and grade levels. Overall, the CSO is confident the academy has the support in place to increase its capacity to improve the educational outcomes of students.


Educational Goals




