Detroit Prep's management organization is integrated within the school and provides good support, particularly in operations. The school continues to stay true to their mission of a diverse by design school, even as enrollment is shy of projections. Fundraising continues to be a strength and the board remains engaged and supportive, while continuing to push success and improvement. 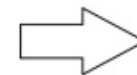
Detroit Prep opened in 2016 and currently educates in grades K-5. They moved into their new facility in 2019.

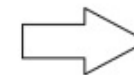
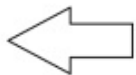

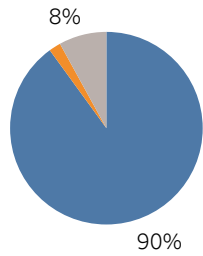


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2019-20 Student Resident Districts
