Summary

Highly-qualified, passionate faculty and staff create challenging, relevant, and meaningful lessons, while caring for the whole child.

CSO Capacity Analysis

Lincoln-King Adams-Young Academy Middle and High Schools are finding fiscal and organizational stability after its first year as an independent district, having split from the Washington-Parks Academy District at the close of the 2020-21 academic year. Academically, the school has struggled to meet its educational goals as stated in the charter contract. The CSO has observed that the academy board is actively pursuing steps to improve its effectiveness. The CSO has also observed that the board, academy leadership, and education service provider are aligned in their work to further the mission of the academy and increase academic outcomes. The CSO has observed that the academy consistently struggles to meet deadlines for compliance reporting, as set in the Master Calendar of Reporting Requirements in the charter contract. Additionally, the school ended the year in a financial deficit and will be obligated to submit a Deficit Elimination Plan with the Michigan Department of Education. In total, the CSO believes that the academy has the supports in place to increase its capacity to grow its educational program and strengthen student outcomes, especially with the plan to consolidate all high school grades to one building in 2022-2023.


