TUITION COSTS

2019-2020 RATES

	Tuition Cost Per Semester	Tuition Cost Per Year
Michigan Resident	\$6,430 per semester	\$12,860 per year
Non-Resident	\$9,148 per semester	\$18,296 per year

- Block rate of tuition for 12-15 credits per semester
- Additional charges for on-campus housing and meal plans will vary based on student's choice

FRESHMAN HOUSING & DINING COSTS

Traditional Living Center	\$4,410 per semester	\$8,820 per year
Suite Style Living Center	\$4,620 per semester	\$9,240 per year
Cluster-Style Living Center	\$4,795 - \$4,970 per semester	\$9,590- \$9,940 per year
1 Bedroom/2 Person Apartment Style	\$4,795 per semester	\$9,590 per year
2 Bedroom/2 Person Apartment Style	\$5,025 per semester	\$10,050 per year

PAYING THE BILL

PAYMENTS FOR THE FALL 2019 SEMESTER ARE DUE BY 5PM ON AUGUST 16TH

Payment options:

- Pay any remaining balance owed by **August 16th**
- Enroll in the deferment plan – four equal payments each semester
 - There is a \$40 fee **each semester** that you are on the deferment plan
 - First payment is due **August 16th**

Non-payment will result in classes being dropped!

PAYING THE BILL

- Cash – in person
- Check – in person, by mail
- Electronic check – online, no fee
- Debit or Credit Card – over the phone, online
 - Note: There is a \$20 convenience fee for **all** credit and debit card payments

GUARDIAN/FAMILY ACCESS

- Students are able to grant permission for an individual (proxy) to view selected student information in myBanner
 - The student authorizes the proxy and what items the proxy may see
 - If someone other than the student will be paying the bill, the student must designate that person as a proxy in order for them to view and pay the bill
- Students are able to grant permission for an individual to discuss their account with the Student Accounts Office through the Messages/Documents tab in myBanner

Late July	Fall bills are sent
August 16	Fall payment due
August 26	Classes begin
Mid-November	Winter bill notices are emailed
December 13	Winter payment due
January 6	Classes begin
