- 2. Should it become necessary to revise any part of the RFP, notice of the revision will be given in the form of an addendum to all prospective suppliers on record as having received the RFP. Any addendum notices will also be posted on the <u>Bid Opportunities</u> page of the GVSU Procurement Services website <u>www.gvsu.edu/purchasing</u>.
