- 7. Vehicle must be free from all dealer advertising/promotional decals.
- 8. Please include in the quote licenses plate title transfer cost.
- 9. Successful bidder will be responsible for order verification and specifications accuracy.
- 10. Successful bidder will be responsible for providing all operation manuals, any necessary operation instructions and delivery to site.
- 11. Specify vehicle warranties, other guarantees and/or services as appropriate.
