## Services Covered

Supplier will perform all necessary preventive maintenance and basic service repairs per the manufacturers' recommendations. Basic maintenance services will be performed onsite at The Meadows by supplier's technicians. Supplier's technicians will be onsite a minimum of two times per week from April $1^{\text {st }}$ through October $31^{\text {st }}$ each year to make sure that all maintenance and adjustments are made on a timely basis. Major maintenance and repairs to be done at the supplier's facility at their discretion.
